LABELING REQUIREMENTS AND USING THE PNOR (RTPO) SEAL

When the Peru National Organic Regulation is requested for certification with OCIA, your operation may label your products or ingredients as organic and may use the National Seal “Peru Organic” on advertisements, labels, tags and/or packaging, **ONLY** if the product meets the requirements set by the SENASA’s Reglamento Técnico para los Productos Orgánicos (RTPO). **Peruvian labeling requirements are based on the percentage of organic ingredients in a product.** Article 61 of the Decreto Supremo 044-2006-AG indicates **at least 95% of a product’s ingredients (by weight) must be certified organic for the product to be considered “organic.”**

The National Seal Peru Organic may appear on organic agricultural products containing at least 95 percent organic ingredients (“organic”). Use of the Peru Organic seal is optional. Products certified to the PNOR are not required to display the Peru Organic Seal.

For processed products, including those with additives, the following labeling requirements apply:

Products that are at least 95% organic may use the Peru Organic seal.

When a product contains 70% to 94% organic ingredients, the word "organic" may be used to indicate a phrase such as "made with organic ingredients" as long as the percentage of organic ingredients is indicated.

For products that contain less than 70% organic ingredients, “organic” may only appear in the list of ingredients. Such products cannot be called "organic" or "made with organic ingredients" nor can the Peru Organic seal be displayed on these products.

All ingredients must be listed on the product label in order of decreasing amount according to the percentage contributed by weight. It should be clear which of the raw materials are of certified organic origin and which are not, and all additives must be disclosed by full name.

Labeling Requirements

The following information must be included on the label and be legible:

- a) Name and address of the person legally responsible for the production or product transformation.
- b) The name or registration number of the certifier.
- c) Number and validity period of the certificate.
- d) The phrase "THIS PRODUCT COMPLIES WITH THE TECHNICAL REGULATION FOR ORGANIC PRODUCTS".

The labels should list the steps of processing that are relevant to the consumer, as well as declare all the components of additives, ingredients and processing aids.

The label’s information panel must show below the name and address of the handler (bottler, distributor, importer, manufacturer, packer, processor, etc.) of the finished product, the statement “Certified organic by OCIA International” or similar phrase, with no other printed material or information being placed between the certifying agent’s name and the name of the manufacturer or distributor. Certifying Agent seals may **NOT** be used to satisfy this requirement. The

business/internet address or telephone number of OCIA International may be displayed on the information panel of the final product.

Imported Products:

The use of the Peru Organic Seal is voluntary. Organic imported products must be labeled in accordance with the standards of national organic production.

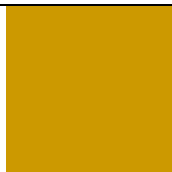
Using the Seal:

Use of the seal is voluntary. If the seal is used it must be legible and indelible and follow the requirements of Decreto Supremo N° 008-2022-MIDAGRI.

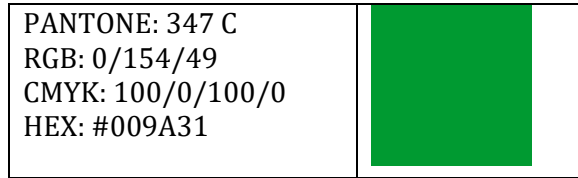
Seal Size: The following measurements are the maximum and minimum allowed for the Peru Organic Seal. The smallest should not be used unless the packaging size requires it.



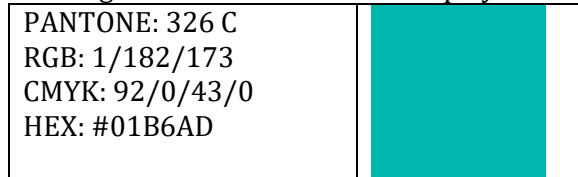
Color: Three colors are used on the seal. Symbolizing the sun, the yellow must be displayed as:

Pantone: 117 C RGB: 204/153/0 CMYK: 13/41/100/3 HEX: #CC9900	
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The representation of Machu Picchu and the word “organic” must be displayed in the following color of green:



The second color representing Machu Picchu must be displayed in the following color of green:



Various versions are available for use, depending on the packaging.
The following version is to be used on white packaging:



For dark packaging:



Position: Around the National Seal or Logo no element, text, printing mark, or the like may be placed below, in front of, or between these two spaces to allow a clean and clear appreciation of the reserved space.

The use of other logos is permitted as long as this reserve space around the national logo is respected



The following uses of the seal are not correct:



*******IMPORTANT NOTICE*******

- **A sample of a label must be sent to OCIA International for review and approval prior to printing and use. Operations who use the Peru Organic Seal without authorization may be fined by SENASA of 2.963% of the UIT up to 10 UIT.**
