Using the Canada Organic Logo

The use of the Canada organic logo is governed by the Safe Food for Canadians Regulations (SFCR) and CAN/CGSB 32.310.



Terms of Use:

Use of the Canada organic logo is voluntary for any organic agricultural product certified in compliance to the CAN/CGSB 32.310. Imported products must meet the requirements of the Canada Organic Regime. If an imported product bears the Canada logo, the statement "Product of", immediately preceding the name of the country of origin, or the statement "Imported From", must appear in close proximity to the logo or the designations.

The Canada logo is only permitted on products that have an organic content that is greater than 95% and has been certified to Canadian requirements for organic products and/or meets the equivalency arrangements between Canada and the European Union and/or Canada and the United States.
